A **Senior AI Compliance Analyst** is the experienced individual contributor who owns the harder AI compliance work: complex assessments, audit readiness across multiple frameworks, and mentoring junior analysts. It is the bridge between analyst work and program management, and a role employers are actively creating as AI governance programs mature.

WHAT A SENIOR AI COMPLIANCE ANALYST DOES

- Leads complex AI compliance assessments end to end
- Owns **audit readiness** and evidence across SOC 2, ISO/IEC 42001, and regulatory requirements
- Interprets new regulation (the **EU AI Act**, sector rules) into program requirements
- Designs controls and improves the compliance process
- Mentors junior analysts and coordinates across Legal, Privacy, Security, and the business

WHAT THE STEP UP REQUIRES

- Several years of GRC or compliance experience with real AI reps
- Deep framework fluency (NIST AI RMF, ISO/IEC 42001) and audit-standard knowledge
- Judgment to balance risk, business needs, and regulatory expectations
- Strong writing and stakeholder management

CERTIFICATIONS THAT HELP

The **IAPP AIGP** plus a senior GRC or audit credential (CISA, CRISC, or CGRC) and, for data-heavy work, a privacy cert.

WHERE IT LEADS

To **AI Governance Program Manager** and compliance-management leadership.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What separates a senior AI compliance analyst from a regular one?

Scope and judgment: owning complex, multi-framework assessments end to end, interpreting new regulation, improving the process, and mentoring, rather than executing defined tasks.

Is this a management role?

No, it is the senior individual-contributor rung. It is the common bridge into AI Governance Program Manager and other management roles.
