Develop and execute a data strategy aligned with business goals, AI initiatives, and long-term value.

DATA GOVERNANCE

Establish policies, standards, ownership, and accountability to ensure consistent and responsible data management.

DATA QUALITY



Ensure data is accurate, complete, consistent, and reliable for trustworthy AI and analytics.

METADATA & DATA CATALOGS

Improve visibility into data assets, lineage, definitions, and relationships across the enterprise.

5



PRIVACY & REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

Support privacy by design and ensure compliance with data protection laws and industry requirements.

6



DATA LIFECYCLE MANAGEMENT

Oversee data classification, retention, archival, and disposal to reduce risk and meet obligations.

AI READINESS

Prepare and deliver high-quality, well-governed data that powers analytics, machine learning, and AI initiatives.

CROSS-FUNCTIONAL LEADERSHIP

Partner with security, legal, compliance, IT, and business leaders to enable responsible and scalable AI.

Why the CDO Matters

The Chief Data Officer sits at the intersection of business strategy, information management, technology, and governance. Key responsibilities include:

- Developing enterprise data strategies
- Improving data quality
- Establishing governance policies
- Managing metadata and data catalogs
- Supporting regulatory compliance
- Preparing data for AI initiatives
- Partnering with executive leadership

Without these capabilities, AI governance becomes significantly more difficult.

The Connection Between Data Governance and AI Governance

Organizations cannot govern AI effectively without understanding the data that powers it. The CDO helps answer essential questions:

- What data is being used?

- Who owns it?
- Is it accurate?
- Is it complete?
- Is it appropriately protected?
- Can decisions be explained?
- Are privacy requirements being met?

Answering these questions reduces organizational risk while improving confidence in AI-driven decisions.
